The following auction is scheduled for 05 March 2025

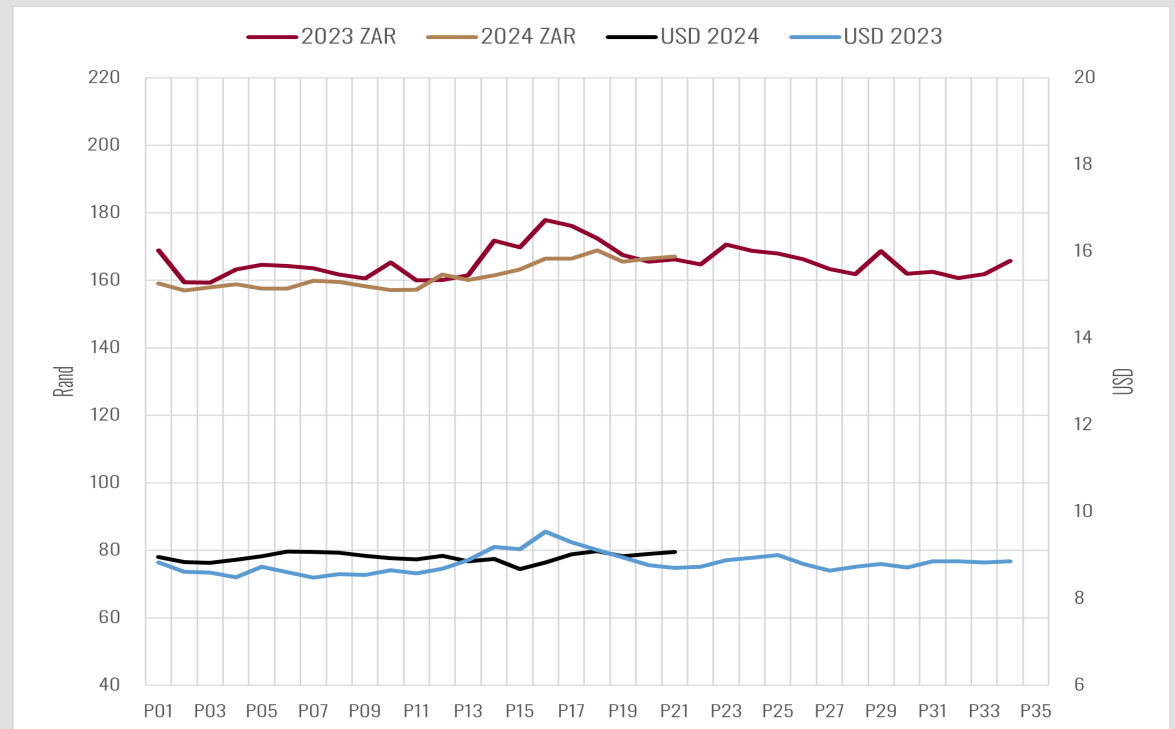
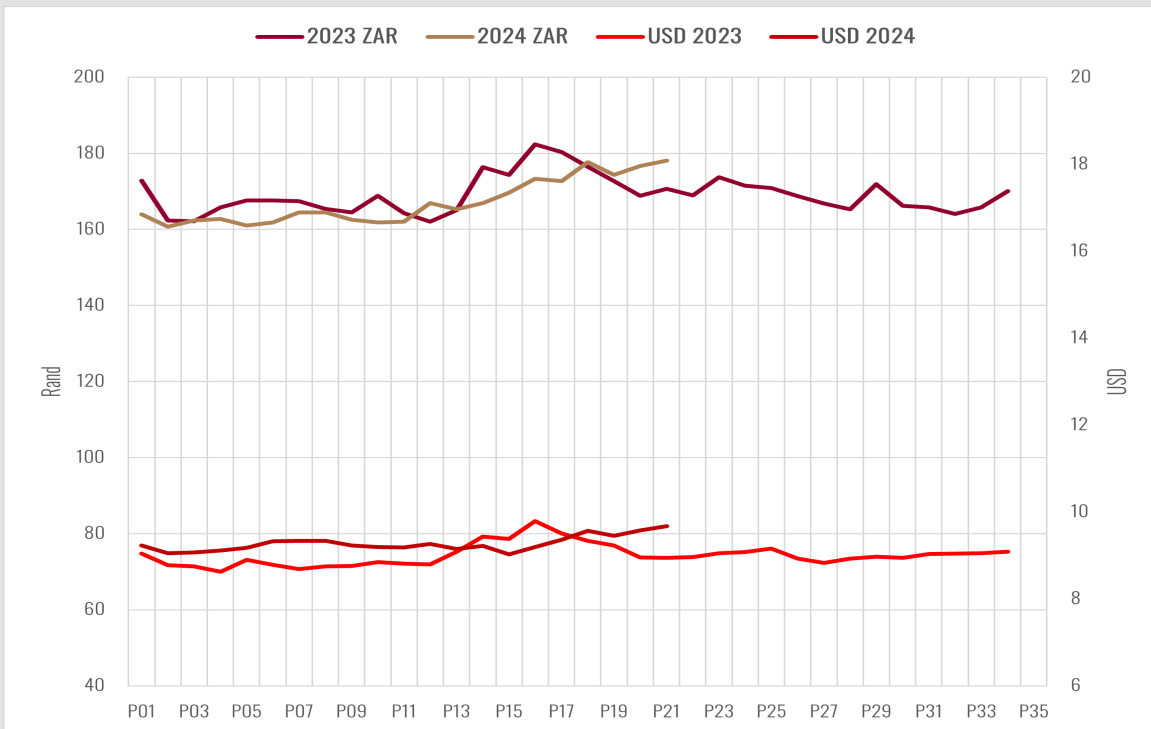
