



WOOL MARKET REPORT – 2 MARCH 2016

On the 25th wool auction of the 2015/2016 season, the Cape Wools merino wool market indicator increased by 2.2% to close on 15429c per kg clean. This is approximately 38.94% higher than a year ago.

Average clean wool price indicators for good quality long fleece wool (MF4/MF5) with a tenstle strength of 35 (NKT) were as follows:

The main buyers on the sale were: Standard Wool (3,686 bales), G Modiano (2,897 bales) Lempriere South Africa (2,714 bales). Of the 12,599 bales offered 12,436 bales were declared sold (98%).
