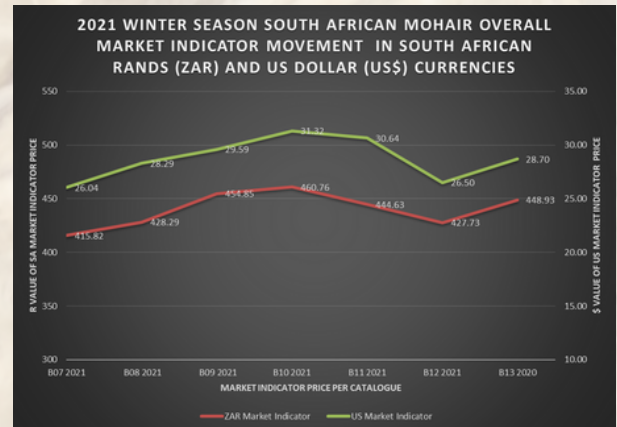

## Comment

The prestigious second last mohair sale of the 2022 summer selling season delivered a mixed bag of emotions with plenty of highlights, but also some disappointment with the lack of demand for the stronger adults. The current COVID pandemic in China plays a key role in this lack of demand because they are the biggest importer of adult mohair. This market should start to recover in the coming winter season when the pandemic subsides in China. The highlights were plentiful with no less than five producers selling their top kids above the R800.00/kg level with Jordi and Gay van Hasselt of Prince Albert taking the top honours at R899.00/kg and Jan and Jannie Lategan from Aberdeen in the second place at R862.10/kg! More than 88% of the offering were RMS mohair with a price difference of R33.86/kg! The last sale of the season will also have excellent quality mohair on offer and the current price trend should continue.
