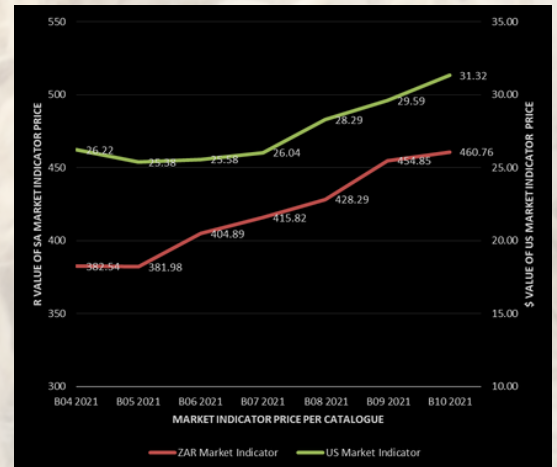

Comment

The 3rd mohair sale of the 2022 summer selling season excelled again! In the previous sale report, We said that this sale would be a good test for the demand because it was virtually double the size of the previous sale, stretched over two days, and the Rand exchange rate was strengthening all the time against the USA\$. Despite all these negatives, the average indicator increased another 1.3%! That is proof that there is tremendous demand for all types of mohair. The House of Fibre offered more than 90% of its catalogue for the first time in history as RMS mohair. RMS clips are also maintaining the R20.00/kg on average gap between RMS and non-RMS mohair. 100% of the offering was sold. The next sale will be similar in size with a lot of seedy mohair in the offering, but fortunately also better individual bales. The good demand is expected to continue on the condition that there is no dramatic movement in the exchange rate.
