

Comment

The fourth mohair sale of the 2022 summer selling season experienced downward pressure caused by multiple reasons and is quite a complex situation. The 3.5% drop on average is not too bad if you consider all circumstances. The Rand strengthened by more than 5% since the first sale, and this is the first sale with a downward tendency. However, the main problem is finance. Although the border of China is not closed for mohair imports, the main shipping ports are struggling because of the new Covid pandemic in China. If the mohair is not delivered, no payments are made, causing havoc in the cash flow of processors. The good news is that the demand for mohair is still excellent, with most of the offerings sold. The House of Fibre wants to congratulate especially Paul Webber from Grahamstown and Johan Lategan from Aberdeen with their excellent kid bales on offer. The two bales sold for R780.00/kg and R783.00/kg, respectively.
