

Comment

The fifth mohair sale of the 2022 summer season was a bit of a disappointment, with the indicator down at 3.8%. Interesting enough, the RMS indicator was just less than 3% down. Non-RMS mohair was down by 5%. In the week running up to the sale, things were in turmoil with the Chinese government officials and South African government officials enouncing that the ban on South African animal products going to China includes mohair. This announcement was unexpected because virtually all the mohair is processed in South Africa, which should exclude mohair from the foot and mouth disease ban. The exchange rate was also in our favour. In reaction to this, the brokers decided to give the buyers extended terms to pay for the mohair, subsidising the farmer to the tune of R100 000 per week. There was also good news with Ray and Donna Hobson from Steytlerville, establishing the top price of the day for their bale of super summer kids at R790.00/kg!
